## CHRISTMAS SHOWS

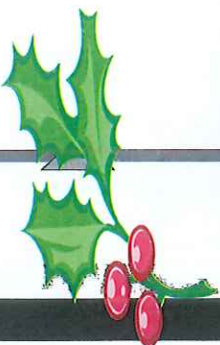
This year we have four different Christmas performances.
