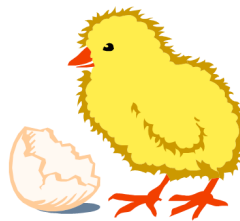
Well - it's that time of year again. Spring has finally arrived - the daffodils and blossom are on their way. At school we will soon be busily preparing for our Spring Festival.

Two members of staff will be leaving at Easter. Mr Gadenne to start a new job and Mrs Larsen to have her baby.

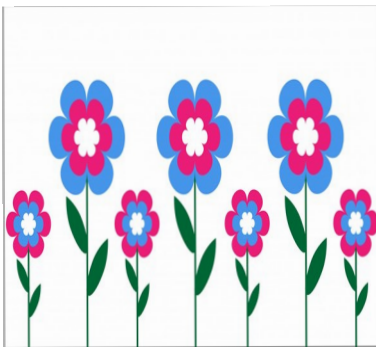
To ensure minimal disruption to our children we will be using existing staff (including myself) to teach in the summer term and will appoint new staff for September.
