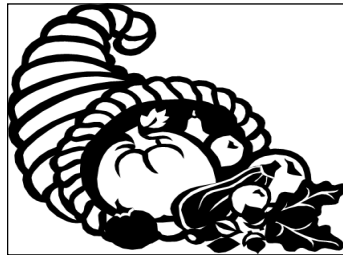

Education Welfare Service.

If your child has three late marks or unauthorised absence, you will be asked to attend a meeting to discuss the situation. The panel will include Education Welfare .

Holidays during term time are not approved and if your child is away for more than 20 days they will be removed from our registers.
