(Be sure to include a key so that we can decipher your code)</p>	<p>English Create a World War II quiz including at least six questions. Challenge your family and friends to answer them.</p>
<p>English/Computing Create a presentation about what you would pack if you were evacuated to another place today, giving your reasons for each item.</p>	<p>Geography Find out about one of the countries involved in World War II. Present some facts about that country at the time. You could include their flag, a picture of their leader and a map of the country etc.</p>	<p>DT Make your own artefact from World War II. This could be a rationing book, an evacuation case, a gas mask, soldier's helmet, a medal or idea of your own.</p>
<p>History/Science The only two Atomic bombs ever used in wartime were dropped during WWII. Find out why, what they were made from, and why they were so damaging.</p>	<p>Art/DT Build a model plane used in WW2. First, research which planes were used by the Allies or Axis, then design and make it.</p>	<p>Art/English/Computing Research and draw a World War II leader, apart from Hitler and include 6 facts about them.</p>
<p>English/Art/Presentation Research popular musicians of the time (e.g. Vera Lynn). Create a poster to show what you know about them. You could even record yourself singing one of their songs.</p>	<p>Maths Design a victory garden. You will need squared paper and sheet 1 from the homework drawer to complete this task</p>	<p>Art/DT Make a model of an Anderson or Morrison shelter.</p>
<p>English/Drama Make a news report about the start of WW2.
