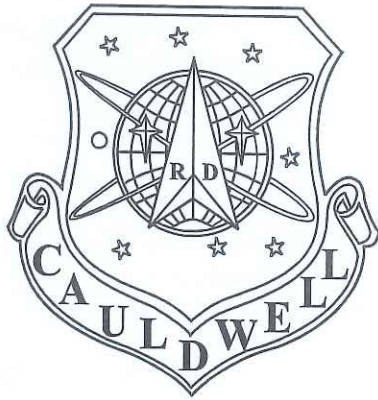

In Maths we have been learning to write Bumpy Number 8. We have been counting Christmas decorations from 1 to 10 when decorating a Christmas tree. We also coloured our own repeating pattern Christmas pictures. Keep practising writing and counting numbers to 20.

Next week we will be practicing for the Christmas Nativity. We will also be writing letters to Father Christmas and writing our own Christmas cards. We will also be doing lots of Christmas craft activities. In Phonics we will continue to practice and learn the sounds a, l, m, s, t, n, o, p and blend these sounds together to read words.
